

Student/Staff/Faculty ID Conversion

Goodbye SSN ...

...Hello DAWG Tag!!!

SIUC is transitioning from using the social security number (SSN) as the Student ID, to be replaced with a system-issued identification number known as the DAWG Tag! Below is information that will help you understand the timeline for this conversion, as well as a link to the website that was created to help answer your questions.

Timeline

Memorial Day Weekend 2008

- DAWG Tag numbers will be created for all existing students, staff, and faculty. The University will begin requiring DAWG Tag numbers (rather than SSNs) on various forms, etc.

June 2, 2008

- We will begin using the DAWG Tag number as the ID for all student services/processes (such as bill payment, Recreation Center, Library). The current ID card will be effective through September 2008.

October 1, 2008

- The current (old) ID card will become obsolete. Everyone must obtain a new ID card (*with the DAWG Tag number printed on the front of the card*) prior to this date (see information below on obtaining a new ID card).

Obtaining a New ID Card

June 2, 2008

- New ID cards will be made in the ID Card Office on the 2nd floor of the Student Center during normal working hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. through 4:30 p.m.).

June 2 – 6, 2008 and June 9 – 11, 2008

- New ID cards will be made in Morris Library on the 3rd floor, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. (Monday through Friday).

August 11 – 22, 2008

- New ID cards will be made in the Kaskaskia/Missouri Rooms on the 2nd floor of the Student Center at various times (please see http://udc.rocks.siu.edu/udc/dawgtag/get_id_card.html for specific times).

August 25 – September 30, 2008

- New ID cards will be made in the ID Card Office on the 2nd floor of the Student Center during normal working hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. through 4:30 p.m.).

Cost

Students, faculty and staff may stop by the ID Card Office June 2nd or after to have your new ID card made for FREE!
